There are approximately 1.3 million maternal deaths that have occurred in India between 1997 and 2020. About 23,800 of those deaths occurred in 2020, with most occurring in poorer states among women aged between 20-29 years. Rural areas of poorer states had proportionately lower access and utilization to healthcare services.

Ignite Asha's mission is to improve the human rights and self-worth of South Asian women and children on a global level. This year Ignite Asha is partnering with Save a Mother (SAM) to help decrease maternal mortality in villages across India by developing and implementing health care awareness solutions for the poor in rural India. SAM's priority is to reduce maternal mortality by training volunteers in villages to educate women on maternal and infant health.
